

2021 was another unconventional year, but you stepped up in huge ways! While we have faced any difficulties, it has also been a time of celebration. Through the generosity of your gifts and time, you allowed our church to continue living out our mission in very tangible ways:

- 1,000 Advent at Home Kits were delivered last Christmas.
- The first Northwest Business Incubator was launched as a key effort to dismantle racism.
- We reopened for in-person worship in March!
- Over 300 people attended Pride Party in June (158 were new to St. Luke's!).
- As a church, we raised over \$40,000 for Back-to-School Extravaganza in July.
- 350+ people came out for I Love My City to do projects to help our local community.
- 1,250 people were a part of the in-person Back to Church Celebration in August.
- In September, our church raised \$57,000 for Afghan Refugee Assistance.
- More than 500 individuals attended our first ever Truck Town event (with over 200 being new to St. Luke's).
- We launched a new website and monthly newsletters to improve our communication with you!

God has truly blessed us during this season so that we could be a blessing to our community and beyond. We thank you for continuing to be the church and having the vision to give from your heart and your faith.

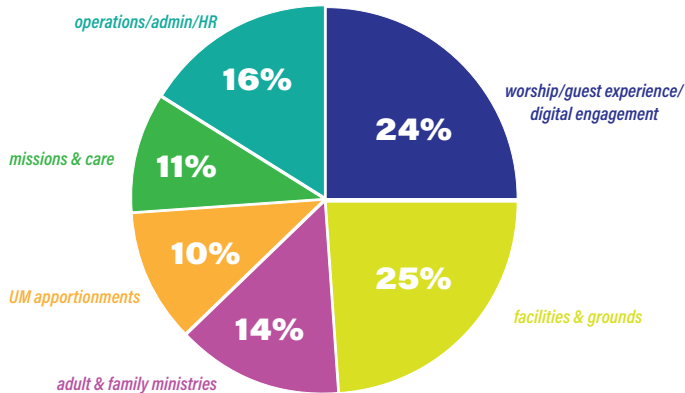

PLEDGING FAQs

Q: What is a pledge?

A: A pledge is a promise of financial gifts to St. Luke's for the coming year.

Q: How can I submit my pledge?

A: This year, you can submit your pledge in one of four ways:

ONLINE - you may set up an electronic recurring gift at stlukesumc.com.

IN PERSON - bring your pledge card to worship on Sunday, November 15, if you choose to worship with us live.

PHONE BANK - phone in your pledge on Sunday, November 14 from 9:30AM-12:30PM at 317-846-3404.

DROP OFF - at the main office any week day between 8:30Am and 5PM.

Q: Can I make my pledge electronically?

A: Absolutely! Please visit rock.stlukesumc.com/pledge to make your pledge electronically. When you make an electronic pledge, you do not need to fill out a paper pledge card.

Q: Can I prepay my 2021 pledge?

A: Sure! You can either drop off a check at the office or prepay online.
